

Moss Stitch Cowl

Skill Level: Beginner

Materials:

1 skein Lion Brand Wool Ease Thick and Quick in Cranberry (640-138)

- 170g/106 yd per skein

- substitute with any super bulky weight yarn

yarn needle

Crochet Hook: 9.0mm [US-N]

Finished Measurements: 22" circumference x 10" high

Gauge: 2"= 4 SCs and 5 rows

Note before beginning: Leave a long beginning tail (at least 24") for sewing the cowl at the end.

Cowl Instructions

Row 1: FSC 44 times. 44 STS

Alternate Beginning Note: If you do not want to use foundation single crochets, you can instead:

Row 1: CH 45, turn, beginning in 2nd CH from hook, SC across. 44 STS

Row 2: Turn, CH 1, *SC, CH 1, skip next ST*; repeat from * to * across to last ST, SC. 44 STS

Row 3: Turn, CH 1, SC, *SC in CH 1 space, CH 1, skip next ST*; repeat from * to * across to last 2 STS, SC in next CH 1 space, SC. 44 STS

Row 4: Turn, CH 1, SC, CH 1, skip next ST, *SC in CH 1 space, CH 1, skip next ST*; repeat from * to * across to last ST, SC. 44 STS

Row 5-23: alternate Repeating **Rows 3 and 4** ending with a **Row 3** repeat. 44 STS

Row 24: Turn, CH 1, SC in each ST across. 44 STS

Fasten off

Finishing

Butt ends together and using your long beginning tail, join with a mattress stitch to form cowl.

Abbreviations Used:

CH: chain

DC: double crochet

FSC: foundation single crochet

RND: round

SL ST: slip stitch

ST(S): stitch(es)

...- pattern repeat, work the stitches contained within the asterisks across the body of the project when called for. The pattern will tell you when to stop the repeat.
