

Snowflake Motif

Skill Level: Intermediate

Materials:

Scrap of light weight or fingering weight yarn in your choice of color

- You can also use Crochet Thread or even worsted weight yarn for a large snowflake (see video for more on substituting)

Yarn needle

Spray Starch

Blocking Board and Pins

Crochet Hook: 3.0mm [US-C]

Finished Measurements: 3.5" wide x 3.5" high

CH 4, join with SL ST to form ring.

RND 1: CH 3 (counts as a DC), DC in ring, CH 4, [DC 2 times in ring, CH 4] 5 times. Join RND with SL ST in top of CH 3.

RND 2: CH 1, [(SC 3 times, CH 2, SC 3 times) all in next CH 4 space] 6 times. Join RND with SL ST in CH 1.

RND 3: [CH 4, (SC, CH 6, SC, CH 7, SL ST in 5th CH from hook, CH 2, SC, CH 6, SC) all in next CH 2 space, CH 4, skip next 3 STS, SC] 6 times. Fasten off and weave in ends.

Block with preferred method. The video tutorial that accompanies this pattern shows blocking with spray starch.

Abbreviations Used:

CH: chain

DC: double crochet

RND: round

SC: single crochet

SL ST: slip stitch

ST(S): stitch(es)

(x): work all the stitches within the parenthesis in the stated ST.

[...] x times- stitch repeat, work the stitches contained within the brackets the amount of times as stated directly after the brackets.
