

# My Butterfly Scarf

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**Skill Level:** Intermediate

**Materials:**

280 yards of Lion Brand Landscapes in Tropics (200)

- 100 g/147 yards per skein
- substitute with medium worsted weight yarn

Yarn or tapestry needle

**Crochet Hook:** 5.5mm [US-I]

**Gauge:** 2"= 8 STS and 4 rows

**Finished Measurements:** approx. 4" across x 50" long

**Special Instructions for Pattern:**

- Read through pattern before beginning.
- CH 3 counts as s DC throughout.
- The BS (butterfly stitch) does not count as a ST when it is worked. It is being worked around the posts of the row below. Do not include it in your stitch count.

## Special Stitch

### Butterfly Stitch (BS):

(CH 2, SL ST, [DC, TR, DC, SL ST] 2 times) all around post of next DC of row below, turn your work 180 degrees so previous DC post is facing you and (SL ST, [DC, TR, DC, SL ST] 2 times, CH 2) all around post of previous DC of row below.

**Note:** Tighten down after every SL ST to get well defined wings.

## Scarf Instructions

CH 18

**Row 1:** Turn, beginning in 4th CH from hook, DC in each CH across. 16 STS

**Rows 2-4:** Turn, CH 3, DC in each ST across. 16 STS

**Row 5:** Turn, CH 3, DC in next 7 STS, BS around next and previous DC posts of row below, DC in ST where BS was just made, DC in remaining 7 STS. 16 STS

**Row 6:** Turn, CH 3, DC in each ST across. 16 STS

**Row 7:** Turn, CH 3, DC in next 10 STS, BS around next and previous DC posts of row below, DC in ST where BS was just made, DC in remaining 4 STS. 16 STS

**Row 8:** Turn, CH 3, DC in each ST across. 16 STS

**Row 9:** Turn, CH 3, DC in next 4 STS, BS around next and previous DC posts of row below, DC in ST where BS was just made, DC in remaining 10 STS. 16 STS

**Rows 10-12:** Turn, CH 3, DC in each ST across. 16 STS

**Rows 13-100:** Repeat **Rows 5-12** ending with a **Row 12** repeat. 16 STS

## Finishing

Fasten off and weave in ends. Block scarf if you would like the butterflies to lay flatter.

CH- chain  
DC- double crochet  
BS- butterfly stitch  
SL ST- slip stitch  
ST(S)- stitch(es)
