

My Flower Garden Scarf

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Skill Level: Intermediate

Materials:

280 yards of Lion Brand Landscapes in Boardwalk (201)

- 100 g/147 yards per skein
- substitute with medium worsted weight yarn

Yarn or tapestry needle

Crochet Hook: 5.5mm [US-I]

Gauge: 2" = 7 STS and 4 rows

Finished Measurements: approx. 6" across x 36" long

Special Instructions for Pattern:

- Read through pattern before beginning.
- CH 3 counts as s DC throughout.
- The FS (flower stitch) does not count as a ST when it is worked. It is being worked around the posts of the row below. Do not include it in your stitch count.

Special Stitch

Flower Stitch (FS):

([DC, CH 3, SL ST in 3rd CH from hook] 6 times) all around post of next DC of row below, turn work 180 degrees so previous DC post is facing you, ([DC, CH 3, SL ST in 3rd CH from hook] 6 times) all around post of previous DC of the row below, SL ST in 1st DC of flower.

Scarf Instructions

CH 24

Row 1: Turn, beginning in 4th CH from hook, DC in each ST across. 22 STS

Rows 2-4: Turn, CH 3, DC in each ST across. 22 STS

Row 5: Turn, CH 3, DC in next 4 STS, *FS around post of next and previous DC of row below, DC in top of same DC where FS was started (stich behind flower)*, DC in next 11 STS; repeat from * to * once more, DC in last 4 DC. 22 STS

Rows 6-8: Turn, CH 3, DC in each ST across. 22 STS

Row 9: Turn, CH 3, DC in next 10 STS, FS around post of next and previous DC of row below, DC in top of same DC where FS was started (stitch behind flower), DC in last 10 STS. 22 STS

Rows 10-12: Turn, CH 3, DC in each ST across. 22 STS

Row 13: Turn, CH 3, DC in next 4 STS, FS around post of next and previous DC of row below, DC in top of same DC where FS was started (stitch behind flower), DC in last 16 STS. 22 STS

Rows 14-16: Turn, CH 3, DC in each ST across. 22 STS

Row 17: Turn, CH 3, DC in next 10 STS, FS around post of next and previous DC of row below, DC in top of same DC where FS was started (stitch behind flower), DC in last 10 STS. 22 STS

Rows 18-20: Turn, CH 3, DC in each ST across. 22 STS

Row 21: Turn, CH 3, DC in next 16 STS, FS around post of next and previous DC of row below, DC in top of same DC where FS was started (stitch behind flower), DC in last 4 STS. 22 STS

Rows 22-24: Turn, CH 3, DC in each ST across. 22 STS

Rows 25-68: Repeat **Rows 9-24** ending with a **Row 20** repeat. 22 STS

Row 69: Repeat **Row 5**. 22 STS

Rows 70-72: Turn, CH 3, DC in each ST across. 22 STS

Finishing

Weave in ends. Block scarf if you would like the flowers to lay completely flat.
