

Flower in a Square Motif

Skill Level: Intermediate

Materials:

- Small amount of medium worsted weight in Blue or color of choice **CA**
- Small amount of medium worsted weight in Green or color of choice **CB**

Crochet Hook: 5.0mm [US-H]

Finished Measurements: approx. 5" square

Motif Instructions

RND 1: With **CA**, SC 8 times in magic adjustable loop. Join RND with SL ST in 1st SC.

RND 2: [CH 3, skip next ST, SC in next ST] 4 times. Do not join.

RND 3: CH 1, [(SC, CH 3, DC 4 times, CH 3, SC) all in next CH 3 space] 4 times. Join RND with SL ST in 1st SC.

RND 4: [CH 5, keep chains to back of petal, SL ST between next 2 SCs] 4 times.

RND 5: CH 1, [(SC, CH 3, DC 10 times, CH 3, SC) all in next CH 5 space] 4 times. Join RND with SL ST in 1st SC.

RND 6: [CH 6, keep chains to back of petal, SL ST between next 2 SCs] 4 times. Fasten off **CA**.

RND 7: Join **CB** with a standing DC in any CH 6 space, (DC 3 times, CH 3, DC 4 times) in the same CH 6 space as previous CH 6, [(DC 4 times, CH 3, DC 4 times) all in next CH 6 space] 3 times. Join RND with SL ST in 1st DC.

RND 8: CH 3, *DC in each ST to CH 3 space, (DC, CH 3, DC) all in next CH 3 space*; repeat from * to * around to last corner, DC in each of remaining stitches. Join RND with SL ST in top of CH 3.

RND 9: CH 1, SC in same ST as CH 1, *SC in each ST to CH 3 space, SC 5 times next CH 3 space*; repeat from * to * around to last corner, SC in each of remaining stitches. Join RND with SL ST in 1st SC.

Fasten off and weave in ends.

Abbreviations Used:

CH: chain

DC: double crochet

RND: round

SC: single crochet

SL ST: slip stitch

ST(S): stitch(es)

***...*-** pattern repeat, work the stitches contained within the asterisks across the body of the project when called for. The pattern will tell you when to stop the repeat.

[...] x times- stitch repeat, work the stitches contained within the brackets the amount of times as stated directly after the brackets.
