

One Skein Billow Cowl



Designed by
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Skill Level: Easy

Materials: 1 skein Classic Elite Ariosa Bulky (5) Weight Yarn in Sangria (4827)

- 50 grams/87 yards per skein
- Substitute with any bulky weight yarn.

Crochet Hook: 8mm [US-L]

Gauge: 3" = 2 complete fans, 3 ½ rows

Finished Measurements: Approx. 7" high x 22" around

CH 63, leave a long end for sewing
(about 24" long)

Row 1: Turn, beginning in 2nd CH from hook, SC in each ST across. 57 STS (72)

Row 2: Turn, CH 3(counts as a DC). Skip 3 stitches, *all in next ST (2 DCs, CH 1, 2 DCs), skip 4 STS*; repeat from * to * across, ending with a single DC in last chain of the row.

Row 3: Turn, CH 3 (counts as a DC), skip 3 DCs, *all in CH 1 space (2 DCs, CH 1, 2 DCs), skip 4 DCs*; repeat from * to * across, ending with a single DC in the turning CH (CH 2 made in beginning of **Row 2**).

Note: Your "fans" should be on top of each other, each fan will be worked in the CH 1 space of the fan below.

Row 4-9: Repeat **Row 3**.

Row 10: Turn, CH 1, SC in each ST across.

Fasten off.

Blocking

Soak cowl in a mild detergent (we recommend Soak brand wash) for 10 mins. Then use blocking wires or pins, pull cowl into shape and secure to a firm surface. Allow to dry completely.

Sewing

Fold cowl in half and using tail, perform a mattress stitch to sew cowl closed.

Weave in end.

Abbreviations Used:

CH: chain
SC: single crochet
DC: double crochet
ST(S): stitch (es)
YO: yarn over
SL ST: slip stitch
