



TWINKLE SHAWL



Abbreviations Used:

co- cast on
k- knit
pm- place maker
sm- slip marker
st(s)- stitch(es)
yo- yarn over

DESIGNED BY
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Skill Level: Beginner

Materials:

approx. 500 yards of Audine Wools by Knitcrate - Twinkle DK in Knit Yorker

- Yarn Info: 100g/250 yards per skein
- Substitute with dk weight yarn.

Gauge: 4" = 14 sts and 18 rows in pattern

TAKE TIME TO CHECK GAUGE

Finished Measurements: approx. 30" depth on the diagonal x 80" wingspan

Tools:

- US 8 [5mm] straight or circular needles (your preference)

IF NEEDED, CHANGE SIZE TO OBTAIN GAUGE

- Yarn or tapestry needle

Special Notes:

- Read through entire pattern before beginning.
- The gauge and finished measurements are after blocking.

Shawl Instructions

Using a Garter tab CO 7 sts.

Note: See video for help with this technique.

Row 1: K3, pm, yo, pm, k1, pm, yo, pm, k3. 9 sts

Row 2 and all even rows: Knit

Row 3: K to marker, sm, yo, knit to next maker, yo, sm, k1, sm, yo, knit to next marker, yo, sm, k3.

Odd Rows 5 - 135: Repeat Row 3.

Note: If you are customizing the size, work an odd row last.

After last row, bind off loosely knitwise, fasten off and weave in ends.

Block with preferred method.
