



# CHEVRON INFINITY SCARF COWL



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## Abbreviations Used

**CA/CB:** color A/color B  
**CH:** chain  
**DC:** double crochet  
**DC3TOG:** double crochet 3 together  
**RND:** round  
**SC:** single crochet  
**ST(S):** stitch(es)  
**[...] x times:** stitch repeat, work the stitches contained within the brackets the amount of times as stated directly after the brackets

**Skill Level:** Easy

### Materials:

2 Skeins of Blue Sky Alpaca Sport weight in Red (511) CA

1 skein of Blue Sky Alpaca Sport weight in Capri (539) CB

- 50g/110 yards per skein
- Substitute with any sport weight yarn

### Crochet Hook:

5mm [US-H]

**Gauge:** 2"= 8 DCs and 3.5 rows

**Finished Measurements:** approx. 46" around x 7.5" wide

### Special Instructions:

- Read through the entire pattern before beginning.
- CH 3 counts as a DC throughout.
- If substituting yarn, be sure to divide CA into two balls of yarn if it is not already packaged that way. The 2nd ball will be added at the end of **Row 1** to have a tail

of CA on each side of the project. This will allow you to work the cowl without having to cut the yarn after each color change. See the video tutorial for more information about this.

- Remember not to fasten off the yarn after each row, it will be picked up every third row.
- At the last stitch of each row the next ball of color will be joined. The instructions will remind you at the end of the row instructions, but you need to join during the last stitch.

### Special Stitches:

**DC3TOG:** [YO, insert hook into next ST, YO, pull up loop, YO, pull loop through first two loops] 3 times, YO, pull loop through all four remaining loops on hook. This turns three stitches into one.

**DC Fan:** DC 3 times into the next ST.



## Scarf Instructions

With CA, CH 34

**Row 1:** Turn, DC in 4th CH from hook (3 skipped CHs count as a DC), [DC in next 3 CHs, DC3TOG, DC in next 3 CHs, DC Fan] 2 times, DC in next 3 CHs, DC-3TOG, DC in next 3 CHs, DC 2 times in last CH. 31 STS

Join in 2nd ball of CA.

**Row 2:** Turn, CH 3 ,DC in same ST as turning CH, [DC in next 3 STS, DC3TOG, DC in next 3 STS, DC Fan] 2 times, DC in next 3 STS, DC-3TOG, DC in next 3 STS, DC 2 times in last ST (which will be the top of the CH 3 of the previous row). 31 STS

Join CB.

**Row 3:** Turn, CH 3, DC in same ST as turning CH, [DC in next 3 STS, DC3TOG, DC in next 3 STS, DC Fan] 2 times, DC in next 3 STS, DC-3TOG, DC in next 3 STS, DC 2 times in last ST. 31 STS

Join in CA tail.

**Note:** This is the tail that was dropped 2 rows ago on this side of the work. Run it up along the side of the project, leave a little slack so the cowl can still stretch.

Do this for every row.

You will cover all these running tails with the border at the end. See step-by-step video tutorial if more help is needed.

**Row 4:** Turn, CH 3 ,DC in same ST as turning CH, [DC in next 3 STS, DC3TOG, DC in next 3 STS, DC Fan] 2 times, DC in next 3 STS, DC-3TOG, DC in next 3 STS, DC 2 times in last ST. 31 STS

Join in the 2nd ball of CA.

**Row 5:** Turn, CH 3 ,DC in same ST as turning CH, [DC in next 3 STS, DC3TOG, DC in next 3 STS, DC Fan] 2 times, DC in next 3 STS, DC-3TOG, DC in next 3 STS, DC 2 times in last ST. 31 STS

Join in CB.

**Row 6:** Turn, CH 3, DC in same ST as turning CH, [DC in next 3 STS, DC3TOG, DC in next 3 STS, DC Fan] 2 times, DC in next 3 STS, DC-3TOG, DC in next 3 STS, DC 2 times in last ST. 31 STS

Join in CA.

**Rows 7-81:** Repeat Rows 4-6. 31 STS

Do not fasten off either tails of CA at the end of the scarf, you will use them for the border.

At the end of **Row 81** fasten off CB with a long enough tail for whip stitching the scarf together about double the width of the scarf will be sufficient).

## Joining

With right sides facing each other, use the yarn needle to whip stitch the ends of the scarf together to join.

## Finishing

Turn right side out.

With each ball of CA still attached to opposite sides, use the yarn to SC around each edge of the scarf. Join RND with a SL ST in first SC.

Fasten off and weave in all ends.
