



CUSTOM BEANIE IN DOUBLE CROCHET

DESIGNED BY DEJA JOY



Skill Level: Easy

Materials:

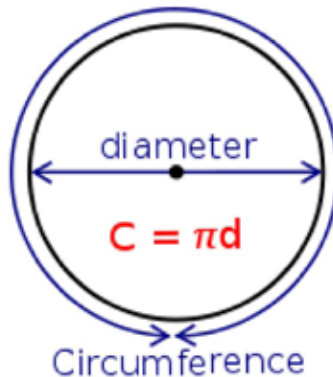
Any worsted weight yarn

- Yardage varies based on size of beanie

Crochet Hook: varies

Gauge: Follow instructions to determine gauge

Finished Measurements: varies



Worksheet

Circumference = total length around widest part of your head

Finding Diameter For Crown of Beanie

Diameter of Circle = Circumference/3.14

Step 1: Substitute the circumference of your head for x in equation below.

Diameter = $x/3.14$

Step 2: Divide the circumference of your head by 3.14 (AKA pi)

Step 3: Round up or down.

To Estimate Number of Rounds You Will Work and Find Correct Hook Size

Step 1: Complete **RND 1 and 2** of beanie with recommended hook size for yarn used.

Step 2: Measure the diameter of **RND 1**.

Step 3: Divide the **RND 1** diameter by the total diameter needed for the crown of the beanie.

Equation: Total Diameter/Diameter of **RND 1**

Step 4: If the resulting number is close to a whole number, use that hook.

If it is not, change hook sizes (either up or down) and again follow the directions above.

Note: The whole number you get with the correct hook will be the number of RNDs to work for the crown on the beanie.



Crown of Beanie

RND 1: 12 DCs in Magic Adjustable Loop. 12 STS

RND 2: CH 3 (counts as a DC), DC in same ST, DC 2 times in each ST around. 24 STS

RND 3: CH 3 (counts as a DC), DC in same ST, DC, [DC 2 times in next ST, DC] 11 times. 36 STS

RND 4: CH 3 (counts as a DC), DC in same ST, DC in next 2 STS, [DC 2 times in next ST, DC in next 2 STS] 11 times. 48 STS

RND 5: CH 3 (counts as a DC), DC in same ST, DC in next 3 STS, [DC 2 times in next ST, DC in next 3 STS] 11 times. 60 STS

Keep increasing by 12 STS until correct diameter is achieved. Then work even stitches around to length you like. Ending ST count should be a multiple of 12.

Body of Beanie RND instructions

No Increase RNDs: CH 3 (counts as a DC), DC in each ST around. ST count will vary depending on your crown size.

Fasten off and weave in ends when happy with size.

Abbreviations Used

CH: chain

RND: round

DC: double crochet

ST(S): stitch(es)
