



# FOLDED RECTANGLE PURSE



**Skill Level:** Beginner

**Materials:**

Approx. 215 yards of Audine Wools Bloom by Knitcrate in Delphinium

- 100g/ 231 yards per skein
- Substitute with any DK weight yarn

**Tools:**

- Size US 7 [4.5mm] needles
- Yarn Needle

**Gauge:** 4" = 18 sts and 36 rows

**Finished Measurements of Rectangle:** approx. 8" wide 24" long

### Bag Instructions

Cast on 36 sts

**Note:** If changing colors when making the rectangle. Do not run the tails along the edge, weave them in.

**Rows 1-256:** Knit.

Bind off and weave in ends, and block if necessary before sewing purse together.

### Purse Handle

Leave a long beginning tail and make a 30 round i-cord with four xx strands of your yarn. Do not weave in ends.

### Finishing

Use the video tutorial for the folding of the rectangle to make the bag. Mattress stitch the seams together.

Attach handle by sewing to each corner of purse and weave in ends back into the handle.
