



DAWN HOODED COWL



DESIGNED BY DEJA JOY

Skill Level: Easy

Materials:

375 yards Lion Brand Wool Ease Thick and Quick in Grey Marble (154)

170g/ 106 yards per skein

Substitute with any super bulky weight yarn

Tools:

Size US 15 [10mm] 24" circular needles

One double pointed needle (dpn) of the

same size or slightly larger (for three needle bind off)

Yarn Needle

Stitch Marker

2 buttons (optional)

Gauge: 4" = 12 STS (in pattern) and 14 rows

Finished Measurements: approx. 30" around x 22" tall



Hooded Cowl Instructions

Worked bottom to top.

CO 90 STS, place marker and join in the RND.

Note: Slip marker after each round to keep track of beginning of round.

Edging

Rnd 1 (RS): *K1,p1; repeat from * around. 90 sts

Rnd 2: *P1, k1; repeat from * around. 90 sts

Rnds 3 and 4: Repeat Rnds 1 and 2 once more. 90 sts

Cowl

Rnd 1: *YO, k2, pass the YO over the k2; repeat from * around. 90 sts

Rnd 2: Knit. 90 sts

Repeat Rnd 1 and 2 until piece measures 6" (including edging).

Next Rnd: Repeat Rnd 1. 90 sts

Hood

Note: Rest of project will be worked in rows.

Row 1: Turn, purl. 90 sts

Row 2: Turn, *YO, k2, pass the YO over the k2; repeat from * across. 90 sts

Repeat Rows 1 and 2 until piece measures 22" (including the cowl and edging).

Finishing

Turn project inside out, so right sides are facing each other.

Hold ends together and use a three needle bind off to seam the top of the hood closed.

Alternate Join: Bind off all stitches and use a length of yarn to whip stitch hood closed.

Weave in ends and turn right side out.

Optional Buttons

Using a piece of scrap yarn, sew on buttons to front of cowl, spaced as you like.



Abbreviations Used:

K- knit
P- purl
CO- cast on
Rnd- round
RS- right side
St(s)- stitch(es)
YO- yarn over
***-** repeat starting point
