DESIGNED BY DEJA JOY

Skill Level: Easy

Yarn:

Approx. 80 yards each of Knit Picks Chroma
Worsted in colors:

- Grey (25884) CA
- Drawing Room (26934) CB
- 100g/198 yards
- substitute with any medium worsted weight yarn

Tools:

- US 8 [5mm] 16" circular needles
- One set US 8 [5mm] DPNs (if needed for decreasing on the crown).
- Yarn or tapestry needle
- Stitch Markers

Gauge: 4" = 16 STS and 34 rows

TAKE TIME TO CHECK GAUGE

Finished Measurements:

Small: Approx. 17" around

Medium: Approx. 20" around

Large: Approx. 22" around

All: Approx. 8" from the top of the crown to the roll in the brim

Special Instructions for Pattern:

- Read through pattern before beginning.
- You can either drop the unused color or fasten off until it is needed again.
- The instructions are written for the smallest size with the other sizes in parenthesis. If there are no parenthesis, the instruction is for all sizes.



Brim

With circular needle and **CA**, cast on 70 (80, 90) sts. Join and pm, taking care not to twist sts on needle.

Rnds 1-8: Knit. 70 (80, 90) sts

Body

Rnd 9: With **CB**, knit.

Rnd 10: Purl.

Rnds 11-12: Knit.

Rnd 13: Purl.

Rnds 14-15: Knit.

Rnd 16: Purl.

Rnd 17: Knit.

Rnd 18: With **CA**, knit.

Rnds 19-26: Repeat **Rnds 10-17**.

Rnd 27: With **CB**, knit.

Rnds 28-35: Repeat **Rnds 10-17**.

Rnd 36: With **CA**, knit.

Rnds 37-44: Repeat **Rnds 10-17**.

Rnd 45: With **CB**, knit.

Rnds 46-53: Repeat **Rnds 10-17**.

Crown

Note: Switch to DPNs as needed during decreasing.

Rnd 54: With **CA**, knit. 70 (80, 90) sts

Rnd 55: [K12 (14, 16), k2tog, place marker] 5 times. 65 (75, 85) sts

Rnd 56: [K to 2 sts before marker, k2tog] 5 times. 5 sts decreased.

Rnds 57-61 (62, 63): Repeat **Rnd 56**. Cut **CA**. 35 (40, 45) sts remain after **Rnd 61 (62, 63)**

Rnds 62 (63, 64)-67 (69, 71): With **CB**, repeat **Rnd 56**. 5 sts remain after **Rnd 67 (69, 71)**

Finishing

Cut **CB**, leaving a long tail. Using a needle, weave tail through remaining sts and pull tightly to close.

Fasten off and weave in ends.

The stitch pattern will cause the brim to curl naturally for the finished look.



Abbreviations Used

CA(B)- color A(B)

dpn- double pointed needles.

k- knit

k2tog- knit 2 sts together (one st has been decreased)

pm- place marker

Rnd- round

st(s)- stitch(es)

[...] x **times**- stitch repeat, work the stitches contained within the brackets the amount of times as stated directly after the brackets.
