



# EASY KNIT BULKY BEANIES DUO



DESIGNED BY DEJA JOY

**Skill Level:** Easy

**Yarn:**

Approx. 98 yards of Sprightly Acrylic Wool Super Bulky in Grey Owl (504-020)

- 150g/98 yards
- substitute with any super bulky weight yarn

**Tools:**

- US 11 [8mm] 16" circular needles
- One set US 11 [8mm] DPNs (if needed for decreasing on the crown).
- Yarn or tapestry needle
- Stitch Marker

**Gauge:** 4" = 12 STS and 16 rows

**Finished Measurements:**

**Small:** Approx. 16" circumference

**Medium:** Approx. 20" circumference

**Large:** Approx. 22" circumference

**All:** Approx. 8" from the top of the crown to the end of the brim

**Special Instructions for Pattern:**

- Read through pattern before beginning.
- The instructions are written for the smallest size with the other sizes in parenthesis.
- Beanies are worked bottom to top.
- Yardage is for largest beanie, you will need 10 yards less for each size down.



## 1x2 Beanie

With circular needle, cast on 48 (60, 66) sts. Join and pm, taking care not to twist sts on needle.

**Rnd 1:** \*p2, k1; repeat from \* around. 48 (60, 66) sts

**Rnds 2-32:** Repeat **Rnd 1**. 48 (60, 66) sts

### Crown

**Note:** Switch to DPNs as needed during decreasing.

**Rnd 33:** \*p2tog, k1; repeat from \* around. 32 (40, 44) sts

**Rnd 34:** \*p2tog; repeat from \* around. 16 (20, 22) sts

### Finishing

Cut yarn, leaving a long tail. Using a needle, weave tail through remaining sts and pull tightly to close.

Fasten off and weave in ends.



## 2x1 Beanie

With circular needle, cast on 48 (60, 66) sts. Join and pm, taking care not to twist sts on needle.

**Rnd 1:** \*k2, p1; repeat from \* around. 48 (60, 66) sts

**Rnds 2-32:** Repeat **Rnd 1**. 48 (60, 66) sts

### Crown

**Note:** Switch to DPNs as needed during decreasing.

**Rnd 33:** \*k2tog, p1; repeat from \* around. 32 (40, 44) sts

**Rnd 34:** \*k2tog; repeat from \* around. 16 (20, 22) sts

### Finishing

Cut yarn, leaving a long tail. Using a needle, weave tail through remaining sts and pull tightly to close.

Fasten off and weave in ends.

### Abbreviations Used

**dpn**- double pointed needles.

**k**- knit

**k2tog**- knit 2 sts together (one st has been decreased)

**p**- purl

**p2tog**- purl 2 sts together (one st has been decreased)

**pm**- place marker

**Rnd**- round

**st(s)**- stitch(es)

**\*...-** pattern repeat, work the stitches after the asterisk across the body of the project when called for. The pattern will tell you when to stop the repeat.
