



# BLOSSOM AND BROOMSTICKS INFINITY SCARF



DESIGNED BY DEJA JOY

**Skill Level:** Intermediate

**Materials:**

- 2 skeins Knit Picks Lindy Chain in Whisper (26465)
  - 50 grams/180 yards per skein
  - Substitute any other fingering, light weight, or sock weight yarn
- 19mm knitting needle
- yarn or tapestry needle

**Crochet Hook:** 3.5mm [US-E]

**Gauge:** 2" = 11 STS and 5 "blossom" rows

**Finished Measurements:** approx. 6" wide x 52" around

**Special Instructions for Scarf:**

- Read through the whole pattern before beginning.
- CH 3 counts as a DC throughout.
- All CH 1 STS do not count towards ST count.
- Watch a video tutorial for the full repeat on my website.



## Scarf Instructions

CH 35

**Row 1:** (DC 2 times, CH 1, DC 2 times) all in 5th CH from hook, \*skip next 3 CHs, (DC 2 times, CH 1, DC 2 times) all in next CH\*; repeat from \* to \* across to last 2 CHs, skip next CH, DC in last CH. 34 STS

**Row 2:** Turn, CH 3, skip next 2 DCs, \*(DC 2 times, CH 1, DC 2 times) all in CH 1 space of row below, skip next 4 DCs\*: repeat from \* to \* across to last 5 STS, skip next 2 DCs, (DC 2 times, CH 1, DC 2 times) all in CH 1 space of row below, skip next 2 DCs, DC in top of turning CH. 34 STS

**Rows 3-5:** Repeat **Row 2.** 34 STS

**Row 6:** Turn, CH 1, SC in each DC across, skip all CH 1 spaces when making the SCs. 34 SCs at the end of the row. 34 STS

For the upcoming broomstick rows, be sure to watch the video tutorial if you've never done broomstick crochet.

**Row 7:** Do not turn, Take loop that is on the hook and enlarge it to fit over your knitting needle, continue pulling up loops by inserting your hook in the next ST from front to back, catch your tail and pull up a loop, then enlarge it to put on your needle through every ST across. 34 STS

**Note:** Be sure to tighten your tail after every couple of loops so you don't have excess slack, failure to tighten will give you uneven "loops" on your next row.

34 loops will be on your needle at the end of the row.

**Row 8:** Do not turn, you will slip off two loops from your needle onto your crochet hook, YO and pull through the two loops on the hook, YO and pull through loop on hook to create a SL ST, SC 2 times into the loop that was created with the SL ST, continue to work across your loops by \*pulling 2 more loops off of the needle, YO, pull through the 2 loops, YO and pull through both loops on hook for your first SC, SC 1 more time in the loop\*. Repeat from \* to \* across. 34 STS

**Note:** This SL ST will only be done at the beginning of each broomstick row.

**Row 9:** Turn, CH 1, SC in each ST across. 34 STS

**Row 10:** Turn, CH 3, skip next 2 STS, (DC 2 times, CH 1, DC 2 times) all in next ST, \*skip next 3 STS, (DC 2 times, CH 1, DC 2 times) all in next ST\*; repeat from \* to \* across to last 2 STS, skip next ST, DC in last ST. 34 STS

**Rows 11- 135:** Repeat **Rows 2-10** ending with a Row 9 repeat. Fasten off with a long tail for sewing.

## Finishing

Line up ends of scarf and using the long tail just cut, whipstitch ends together.

## Abbreviations Used

**CH-** chain

**SC-** single crochet

**DC-** double crochet

**SL ST-** slip stitch

**ST(S)-** stitch(es)

**YO-** yarn over

(...)- perform all stitches within the parenthesis in the ST stated directly after the parenthesis

[...] x times- stitch repeat, work the stitches contained within the brackets the amount of times as stated directly after the brackets.
