



# EASY KNIT BEANIES DUO



DESIGNED BY DEJA JOY

**Skill Level:** Easy

**Yarn:**

Approx. 175 yards of Sprightly Acrylic Worsted in Teal (501-001)

- 100g/201 yards
- substitute with any worsted weight yarn

**Tools:**

- US 6 [4mm] 16" circular needles
- One set US 6 [4mm] DPNs (if needed for decreasing on the crown).
- Yarn or tapestry needle
- Stitch Marker

**Gauge:** 4" = 18 STS and 24 rows

**Finished Measurements:**

**Small:** Approx. 16" circumference

**Medium:** Approx. 20" circumference

**Large:** Approx. 22" circumference

**All:** Approx. 9.5" from the top of the crown to the end of the brim

**Special Instructions for Pattern:**

- Read through pattern before beginning.
- The instructions are written for the smallest size with the other sizes in parenthesis.
- Yardage is for largest beanie, you will need 25 yards less for each size down.
- Beanies are worked bottom to top.



## 1x2 Beanie

With circular needle, cast on 72 (90, 99) sts. Join and pm, taking care not to twist sts on needle.

**Rnd 1:** \*p2, k1; repeat from \* around. 72 (90, 99) sts

**Rnds 2-58:** Repeat Rnd 1. 72 (90, 99) sts

### Crown

**Note:** Switch to DPNs as needed during decreasing.

**Rnd 59:** \*p2tog, k1; repeat from \* around. 48 (60, 66) sts

**Rnd 60:** \*p2tog; repeat from \* around. 24 (30, 33) sts

### Finishing

Cut yarn, leaving a long tail. Using a needle, weave tail through remaining sts and pull tightly to close.

Fasten off and weave in ends.

## 2x1 Beanie

With circular needle, cast on 72 (90, 99) sts. Join and pm, taking care not to twist sts on needle.

**Rnd 1:** \*k2, p1; repeat from \* around. 72 (90, 99) sts

**Rnds 2-58:** Repeat Rnd 1. 72 (90, 99) sts

### Crown

**Note:** Switch to DPNs as needed during decreasing.

**Rnd 59:** \*k2tog, p1; repeat from \* around. 48 (60, 66) sts

**Rnd 60:** \*k2tog; repeat from \* around. 24 (30, 33) sts

### Finishing

Cut yarn, leaving a long tail. Using a needle, weave tail through remaining sts and pull tightly to close.

Fasten off and weave in ends.

### Abbreviations Used

**dpn**- double pointed needles.  
**k**- knit  
**k2tog**- knit 2 sts together (one st has been decreased)  
**p**- purl  
**p2tog**- purl 2 sts together (one st has been decreased)

**pm**- place marker  
**Rnd**- round  
**st(s)**- stitch(es)  
**\*...-** pattern repeat, work the stitches after the asterisk across the body of the project when called for. The pattern will tell you when to stop the repeat.
