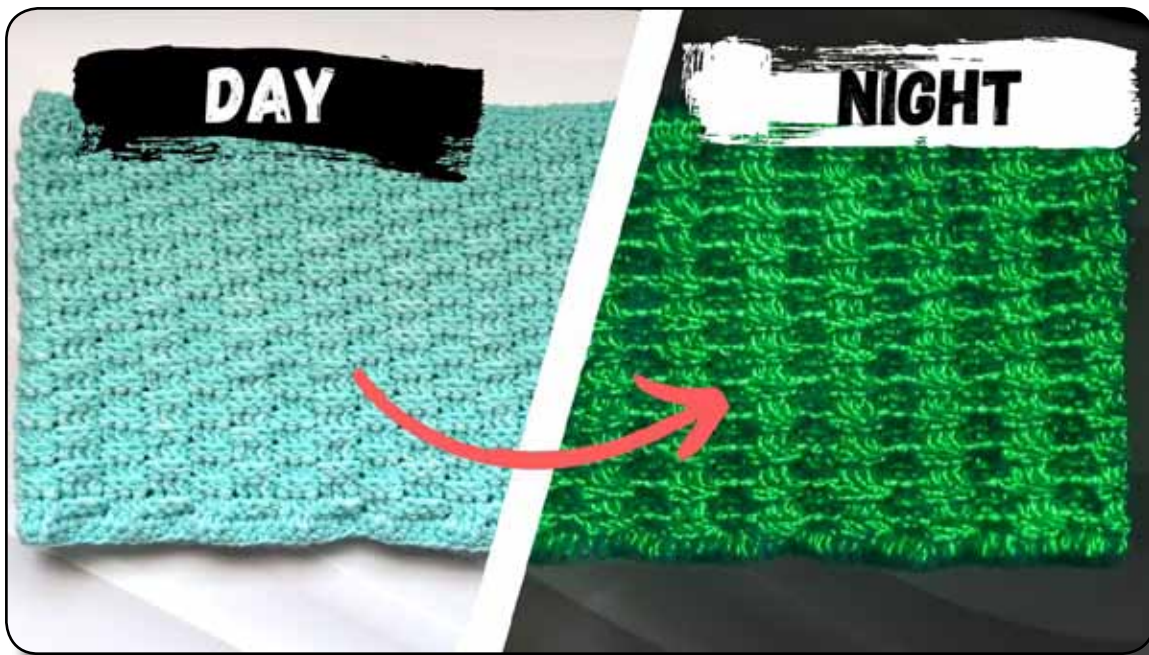




PETITE BASKETWEAVE COWL (GLOW STYLE)



DESIGNED BY DEJA JOY

Skill Level: Intermediate

Materials:

320 yards of Worsted Weight Yarn for base of cowl

160 yards of Lace Weight Glow in the Dark yarn

Yarn or tapestry needle

Crochet Hook: 6mm [US-J]

Gauge: 4" = 14 STS and 12 rows

Finished Measurements: Approx. 24" around x 8.5" high

Special Instructions for Pattern:

- Read through pattern before beginning.

- You will join in the lace weight glow in the dark yarn on RND 2 and drop it every other RND. You can watch how to join in the video tutorial on my website.

Special Stitch

Tall CH: This will be used instead of a beginning CH 3. You will pull up a loop as tall as a DC, then lock it in with another CH. Your first DC will be worked in the first ST of the row. The tall CH does not count as a ST. This will eliminate the gap at the beginning of the RND.

Cowl Instructions

CH 84, join RND with SL ST in 1st CH. 84 STS

RND 1: CH 1, SC in same ST as CH 1 and in each ST around. Join RND with SL ST in 1st SC. 84 STS

RND 2: Tall CH, DC in same ST as tall CH and in each ST around. Join RND with SL ST in 1st DC. 84 STS

Note: Be sure to work the first ST of your round around the same ST as the SL ST and tall CH were made for every upcoming round.

Include the tall chain in the first FPDC and BPDC of each round. Simply wrap your hook around the tall chain and the first ST of the RND as if they were one stitch.

RND 3: Tall CH, *FPDC around next 3 DCs of row below, BPDC around next 3 DCs of row below*; repeat from * to * around. Join RND with SL ST in 1st FPDC. 84 STS

RND 4: Tall CH, *BPDC around next 3 DCs of row below, FPDC around next 3 DCs of row below*; repeat from * to * around. Join RND with SL ST in 1st BPDC. 84 STS

RNDs 5-26: Repeat **RNDs 3 and 4**. 84 STS

RND 27: CH 1, SC in same ST as CH 1 and in each ST around. Join RND with SL ST in 1st SC. 84 STS

Fasten off and weave in ends.

Tall CH Tutorial



Begin tall chain by pulling a chain the height of a double crochet.



Lock in the tall chain with a regular chain.

Abbreviations Used

BPDC- back post double crochet

CH- chain

DC- double crochet

FPDC- front post double crochet

SC- single crochet

SL ST- slip stitch

ST(S)- stitch(es)

...- pattern repeat, work the stitches contained within the asterisks across the body of the project when called for. The pattern will tell you when to stop the repeat.
